- c. Who will be?
- d. Is there an opposition that can break you?
- e. If the opposition cannot break you then – a better question might be what will your opposition use to try to break you?

Main take away

Your enemies are also God's enemies.

Do you know what that means

Fully a Father but Father enough to be soft and nurturing like a mother
